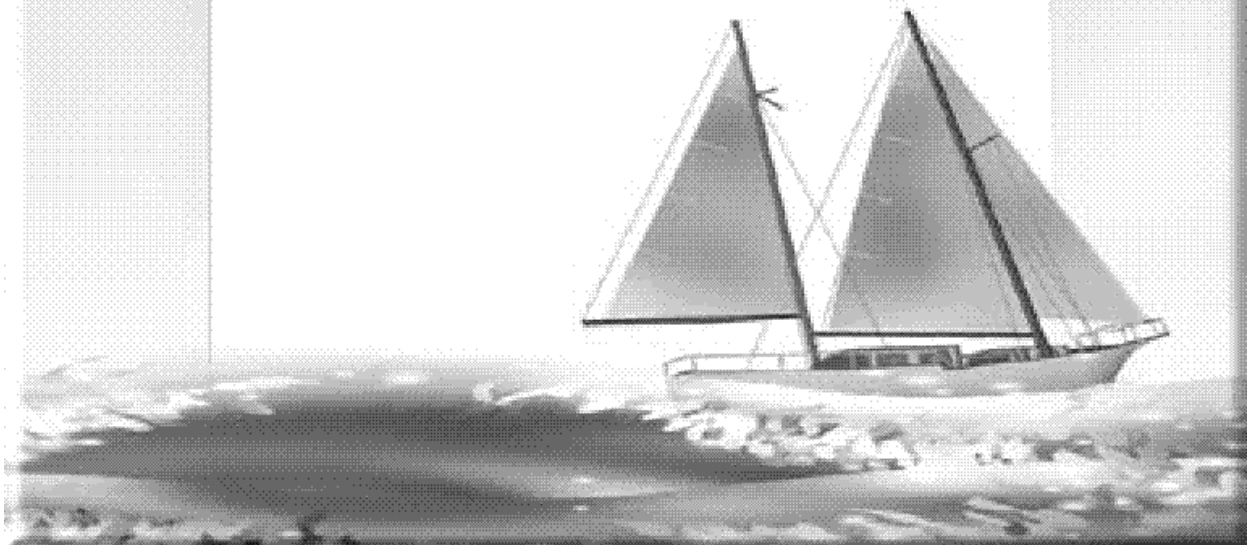

MINUTES

Nevada Yacht Club Executive Board Meeting 9/17/2003 Held at Glenn Frank's Home

Meeting called to order at 1915.

Officers' Reports:

Secretary – Marcie Armstrong, not present. Sherry Gerner took minutes for meeting. Last month's (August) minutes were published in September 2003 newsletter.

Treasurer – Gary Hendricks: presented current Treasurer's report.

Cruising Captain – Jack Crawford, not present. At recent "Labor Day Cruise" on scheduled on Sept. 6 & 7 to clean up Castle Cove, only Glenn Frank and Mike & Cheryl Higgins showed up. Made some improvement, picked up some debris.

Fleet Captain – David Armstrong: Fall Series #1 was Sunday, 14 Sept. Collected \$70.00, 8 boats entered. Temple Bar Race on Oct. 4 & 5, no dinner currently reserved; however, restaurant manager said he would stay open for us (even though the restaurant normally closes at 7 PM). Told him to expect 20-30 people. \$20 early entry fee/\$25 day of race fee. Purchased 8 trophies for Temple Bar Race. NEEDS help with Race Committee for Gold Cup Race on Nov. 8 & 9. Women's Regatta coming up on Oct. 11, Steve Smith to help with Race Committee. Fall Series #2 scheduled for Sunday, Oct. 26, 0900 Skippers' meeting, and Fall Series #3 on Sunday, Nov. 23.

Staff Commodore – Floyd White: Department of Recreation and Community Services will include information on NYC "Learning to Sail" in their quarterly newsletter. Cost is \$70 (of which NYC receives a large portion) is includes 4 hours of actual sailing on the water. Dates of classes will be: Saturdays – Oct. 25, Nov. 15, Jan. 17, Feb. 14, Mar. 13. 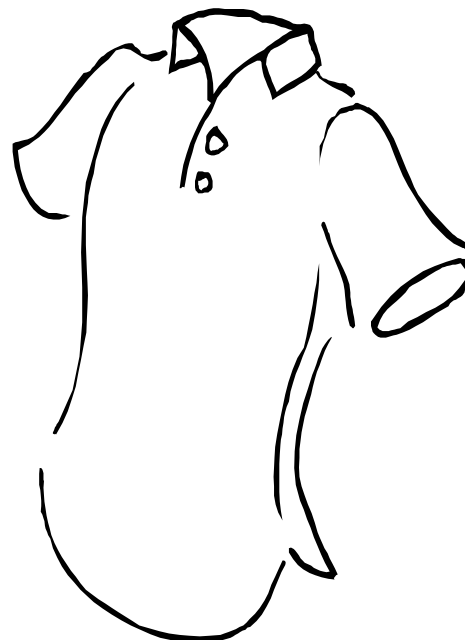
